Sub: CCH Guidelines on UG/PG examination during Covid-19 pandemic/lockdown- reg.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation of this Council's guidelines on Examination of UG/PG courses during Covid-19 pandemic, circulated vide council's letter of even no. dated 08.06.2020, I am directed to say that Council is in receipt of various representations from Universities, Students, and Colleges in this regard. Further, matter has been considered by the Board of Governors, CCH and it decided as under:-

"In view of the emerging situation related to Covid-19 pandemic in Country, Board of Governors decided to issue revised guidelines as under:-

- (a) The examination of final year BHMS/MD (Hom.) Part II, shall be conducted at suitable time as and when the normalcy in the respective state/district is restored by following the protocols/guidelines/advisories/directions issued by the Central/State Governments in view of Covid-19. No specific time frame is prescribed.
- (b) The examination for first/Second/third year BHMS Course/MD (Hom.) Part I, may be conducted by the respective colleges/universities as and when the normalcy in the respective state/district is restored by following the protocols/guidelines/advisories/directions issued by the Central/State Governments in view of Covid-19 pandemic. No specific time frame is prescribed. Further, the colleges are allowed to let the students to commence their studies for next higher classes. However, the students shall have to pass their examination as and when it is conducted by the respective colleges/universities for their previous year of professional BHMS Course.
- (c) Where university has planned for online participation of external examiners, an observer may be appointed by university along with the preservation of complete recording of online conduction of examination compulsorily.
- (d) Rest of the contents of previous guidelines issued by Council vide ref. No 14-22/2018-CCH/dated 08.06.2020 remains same."
