Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer subject cited above and to say that the Ministry has received various representation requesting to reduce the required percentile criteria in the NEET-2020 in order to be eligible for admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H) UG courses, due to various reasons.


2. In this regard, the matter has been examined by the Ministry and decided that in order to be eligible for admission in ASU & H UG courses, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in NEET-2020.

However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35<sup>th</sup> percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST/OBC.

3. This clarification is applicable only for academic year 2020-21.

4. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
